Thank you for your interest in becoming a member of the Troy Fire Protection District. The department has a history that dates to the late 1890's with members of this community volunteering and dedicating their time to form a fire brigades. As today this department is made up of volunteers from the community who give their time and dedication to the community's safety and wellbeing. Prospective volunteers must realize this can be a physically, emotionally, and psychologically demanding job.

Our application period is always open at the discretion of the Chief, we are always looking for highly motivated individuals who are willing to dedicate their time and effort to help keep the lives of their community safe and be there in their times of need.

Enclosed you will find the "Troy Fire Protection District Firefighter Job Summary" which will provide you with a general overview as to what will be expected. This should be read in full before submitting your application.

You must live within the Troy Fire Protection District, be 18 years of age, complete this application in full and possess or able to obtain a valid Illinois driver's license in order to be considered for a position. Some locations in the district do not have a Troy address, you may check with the department if you are not sure if you reside in the district. If you have any questions regarding this application, you can call (618) 667-6722 and leave a message. Someone will return your call as soon as possible to assist you.

Make sure you sign and date the Authorization page. This must be signed in order to complete a background check, you are filling a position of trust, which requires a background check for all new members.

When an opening occurs, the applications will be reviewed by the Troy Fire Protection District Officers and qualified candidates will be notified for a formal interview. Depending on current membership your notification for an interview could take from a few weeks to a few months. Upon completion of the interview and background/reference check qualified candidates will be presented to the Troy Fire Protection District Board of Trustees for approval at which point you will be notified.

Firefighter Job Summary

JOB SUMMARY: The firefighter is responsible for the application of the scientific principles of fire prevention, suppression and investigation. For the rescue of victims and mitigation of hazards and first aid within the scope of training and available resources through knowledge, experience and leadership. Firefighter selection is the task of the Troy Fire Protection District Officers and approval of the Troy Fire Protection District Board of Trustees.

JOB RELATIONSHIPS: Reports to the Captain(s). Interacts continually with the other personnel and Officers, frequently with the general public and other fire departments, and occasionally with organized groups.

RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES: Responds to all emergencies and calls for service expediently and safely. Follows the instructions of the Incident Commander and Officers. Operates all apparatus and equipment safely and proficiently. Adheres to the Standard Operating Guidelines and Policies of the Troy Fire Protection District. Adheres to the By-laws of the Troy Fire Department. Performs life safety, fire suppression, property conservation and other duties as assigned at emergencies and calls for service. Inspects apparatus and equipment of the Troy Fire Protection District regularly and performs housekeeping duties for apparatus, equipment and properties of the Troy Fire Protection District. Advises the proper authority of apparatus/equipment defects. Carries out duties as assigned by the Officers of the Troy Fire Protection District. Performs other duties as required or assigned from time to time. Attends the monthly meeting of the Troy Fire Department to keep informed of the activities of the Department and District. Attend monthly (three events per month) training and drills carried out by the Troy Fire Protection District.

KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS: Requires thorough knowledge of the geography of the Troy Fire Protection District. Requires extensive knowledge of the principles and practices of firefighting, fire prevention and first aid and the ability to apply them (Training provided by TFPD). Requires thorough knowledge of all current Standard Operating Guidelines and Policies. Requires possession of a valid Illinois Vehicle Operator's license in the appropriate classification required by law. Requires ability to provide effective leadership and maintain harmonious relationships with all personnel. Requires the ability to communicate effectively, both orally and in writing. Requires the ability to prepare accurate and concise reports. Requires the ability to adapt to special situations and respond in an effective manner.

WORKING CONDITIONS: Normal hearing and vision, or correctable to a normal level. Possess physical strength, endurance, agility. Produce extreme effort and energy for periods of time in highly stressful situations, retaining presence of mind, working as a team member to abate an emergency. Operate heavy equipment in accordance with traffic laws while demonstrating manual dexterity and safety for all concerned.

EXPOSURE CATEGORY: Category I - Tasks that involve exposure to blood, body fluids or other potentially infectious or hazardous materials. Use of appropriate personal protective equipment is required.

I have received and reviewed the Troy Fire Protection District Firefighter Job Summary and can perform these essential functions, with or without reasonable accommodations.

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I understand that this application is based upon the truthfulness of my answers and that no misrepresentation exists. I further acknowledge that any false information given shall be cause for rejection before acceptance or dismissal after acceptance as a member.

If accepted as a member I shall attend required drills, meetings and emergency incidents. I agree to adhere to the Standard Operating Guidelines, policies, procedures, rules, regulations and By-laws of the Troy Fire Protection District and Troy Fire Department.
